From our Pupil Equity Fund Budget £24,512 will be used this session, to allow us to continue to have School Support Assistants (one 5 days and one 3 days), additional to those provided from our SLC core budget. This additional staffing will continue to allow our team to have more flexibility for the delivery of targeted interventions to support small groups and individuals, and to provide additional nurture, where it's needed most. We will also continue to support and encourage families to strive for the highest possible levels of strong attendance for all.
