### Industrial Action - Next Week

As yet, there has been no change to the position from the Trade Unions of School Support Assistants and Facilities Staff (janitorial, kitchen and cleaning staff), on the planned industrial action - Tuesday 26, Wednesday 27 and Thursday 28 September.
