

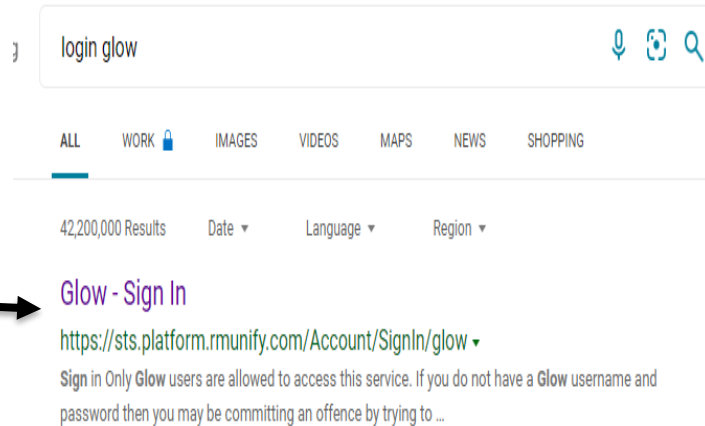
Homework Week Commencing 19 October

As of week commencing 19 October, homework tasks will be set for all children on their Google Classroom. Below shows a simple breakdown of how to access this.

Step 1:

Search login glow in any search engine and then select –

Glow – Sign In

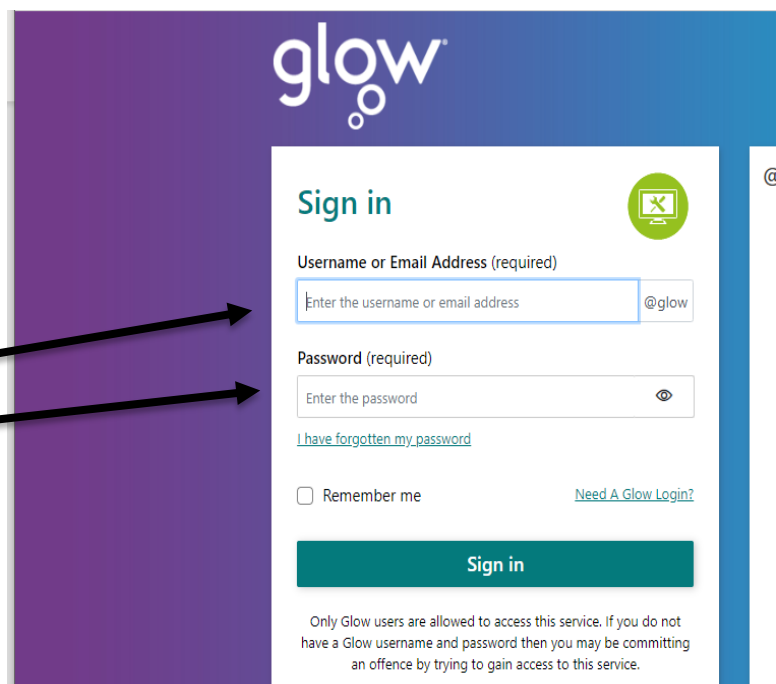


Step 2:

When you select the option shown above you will come to the screen shown on the right here.

Enter username (which is your child's email address) here and the password too.

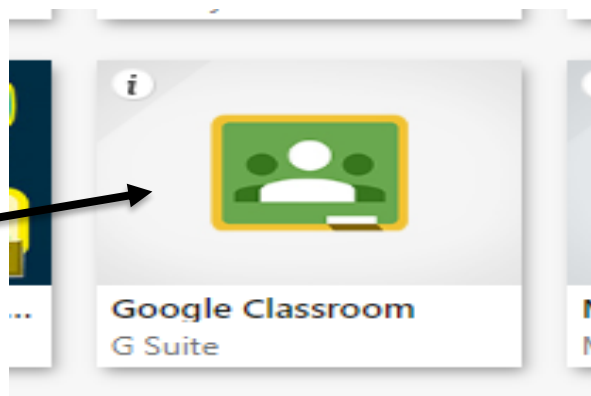
You can find your child's username and password in their homework diary.



Step 3:

You will then arrive at your child's GLOW launch pad.

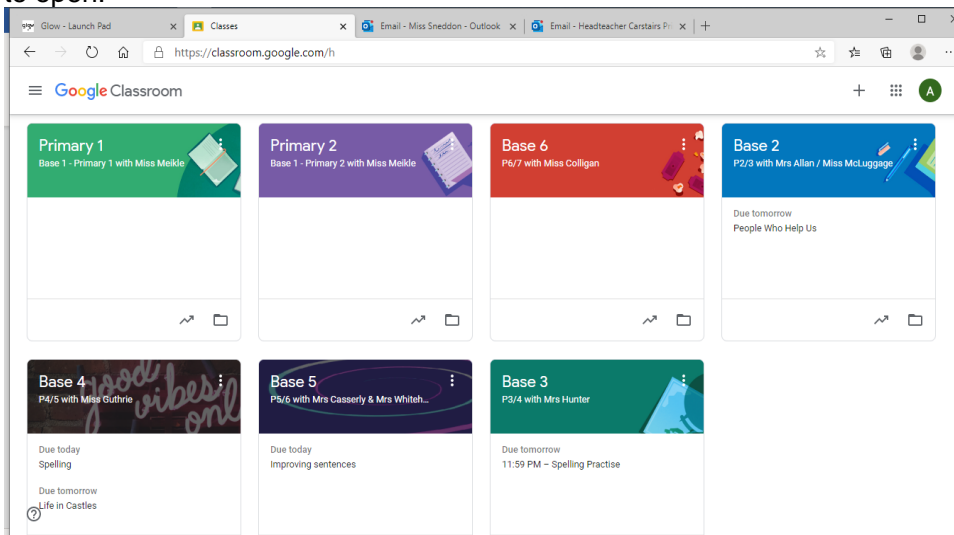
Find the Google Classroom tile on the launch pad and click on it. It looks like this.



Clicking on this will lead you to a page with your child's Google Classroom access.

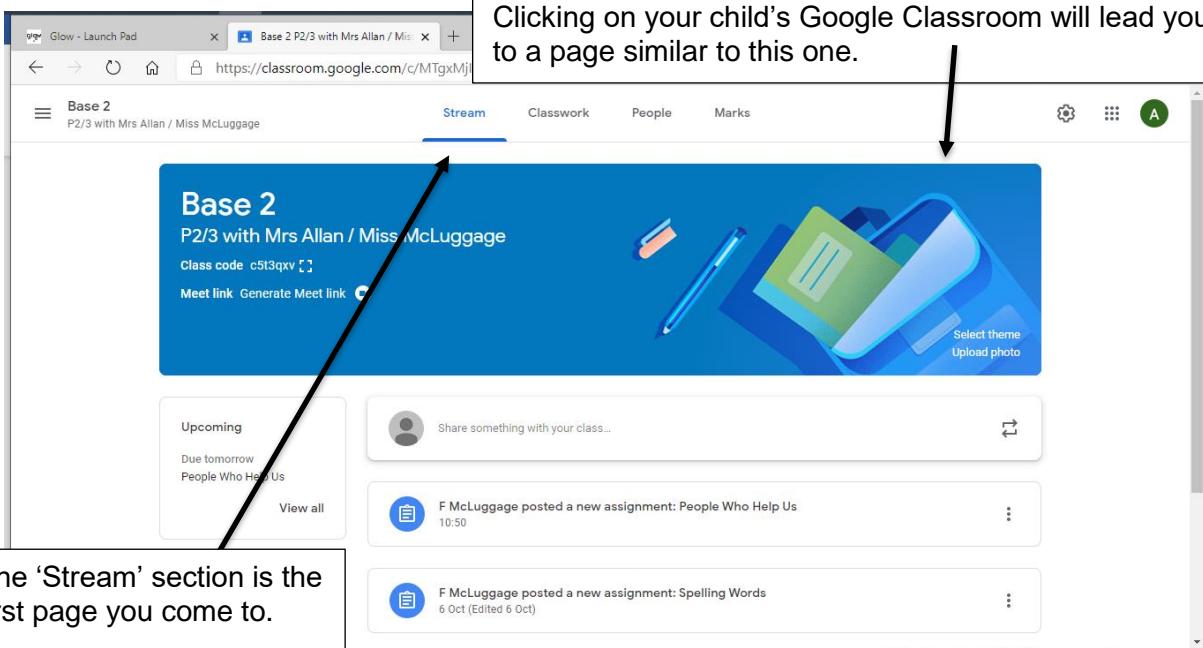
The screenshot below is from mine (HT), so it shows all classes.

Your child's will only have one of the icons that are shown below, specific to his / her class. Click to open.



Click to open your child's Google Classroom.

Note – your child's will only show one of these icons...don't worry that the others aren't there!

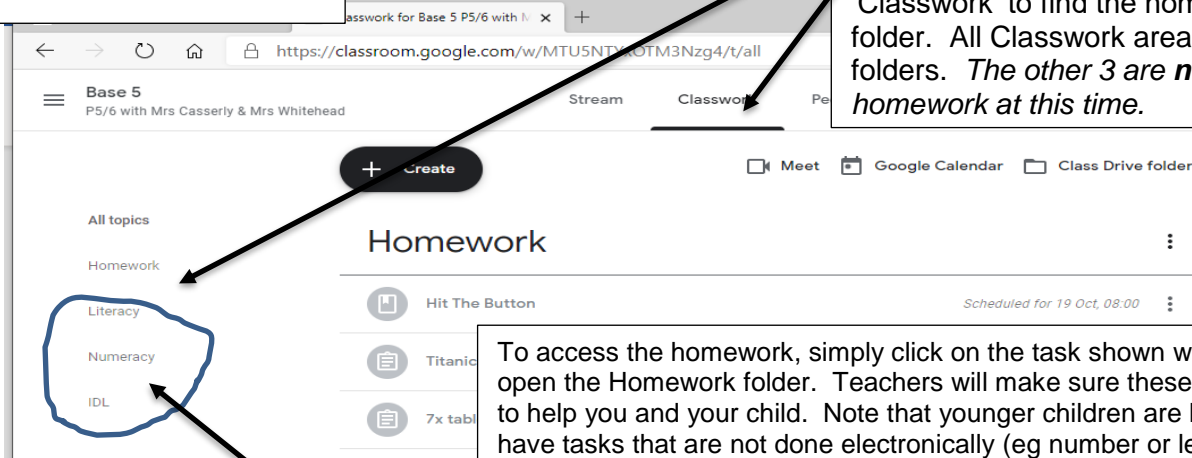


Clicking on your child's Google Classroom will lead you to a page similar to this one.

The 'Stream' section is the first page you come to.

Posts added here are public for all in the group.

Next you need to click in to 'Classwork' to find the homework folder. All Classwork areas have 4 folders. *The other 3 are not for homework at this time.*



You don't need these for standard homework yet (but they will come in handy if having to isolate). 😊

To access the homework, simply click on the task shown when you open the Homework folder. Teachers will make sure these are dated to help you and your child. Note that younger children are likely to have tasks that are not done electronically (eg number or letter practise in salt or sand) and then ask for a comment to be noted in support of completion – parental support to comment will be needed. 😊

Children have all had some experience in their Google Classroom but we do ask for your patience as we all adapt to this new way of working. *Please try not to be daunted – we are in this together!* 😊
