

## Stuff you will need:

- Plastic drinks bottles
- Yoghurt pots or milk cartons
- Wire or string
- Bird seed
- Scissors

## Step by step guide



1. Cut the hole in the side large enough to allow a free flow of seeds, but in such a way that it won't all fall out on the ground in the slightest puff of wind, or get wet if it rains. Get an adult to help you with this part.

2. Make a few small holes in the bottom of your feeder to allow rain water to drain away. Get an adult to help you with this.

3. Hang it with wire or strong string from a tree, hook, or washing line.



Important information: If your feeder starts to wear out or the food goes mouldy, recycle it and make another one. Remember to keep your feeder well stocked, especially for this time of year. Birds come to rely on them and will go hungry if you forget.
